Delaware County Antique Tractor Pulling Rules With the Delaware County Fair

GENERAL RULES:

- 1. Tractors 1980 and older
- 2. Weight classes are: 3000 lbs. to 12000 lbs. max.
- 3. Two wheel drive only. No duals. No steel wheels. Cut tires are OK.
- **4.** The order of pull will be determined by the order of registration. A number indicating the class and order of the pull will be assigned to each driver at registration.
 - If you miss your class 1st call you'll be moved to the last pull in that class.
 - If you miss the final call, you will be pulled from that class with no pull and no refund will be given.
- 5. Registration must be paid **BEFORE** each class starts.
 - Each hook \$10 cash + Gate fee
- **6.** All drivers & drivers' guardians must sign release form at sign up.
- 7. Officials decisions are FINAL
- **8.** All class drivers **MUST** attend driver meeting 15 minutes prior to start of the pulls.
 - Sign up starts @ 5:00 pm
 - Last call for sign up @ 6:15 pm
 - Driver meeting @ 6:45 pm
 - First pulls start @ 7:00 pm

AGE:

9. Drivers must be 16 years of age with parent present / 18 years old or older.

SAFETY:

- 10. No alcoholic beverages permitted for pullers during pulls.
- 11. Drivers must obey all signals from flagmen.
- 12. All participants pull at their own risk.

- **13.** All weights must be securely and/or bolted on.
- **14.** *Safety is our outmost concern*: The Delaware County Fair Board are in no way responsible for accidents or articles lost or stolen.

Speed:

- **15.** MAX speed is 5 mph (low gear)
 - If you exceed speed your first signal will be given as a warning.
 - If your speed exceeds again your second signal will result in a disqualification of the pull with no refund.
- 16. Max Draw bar height 18" inches.
- 17. The first pull in each class may require a sled/weight adjust and will have option for a re-pull.
- **18.** Each class uses a floating finish.
- 19. Must have your own clevis for pulling.
- 20. Tractor tires must stay inside the marked boundaries at all times while pulling.
- **21.** The pullers have two attempts at pull; they may change gear and may restart as long as the puller stops before the marked cones on the track. (before the sled crosses the line)
